BEFORE THE MEETING

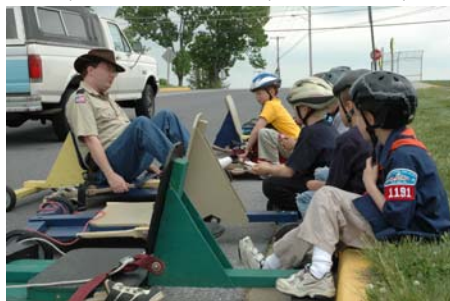
- **Room Arrangement** This meeting is scheduled to be a cubmobile derby in an approved outdoor area with a mild "down-slope"
- **General Materials and Equipment:** Flags, stands, pavilion for shade, emergency kit, FRS radios, stopwatch, orange cones, hay bales, bicycle helmet, street closure permit, drinks

At Least a month before the race:

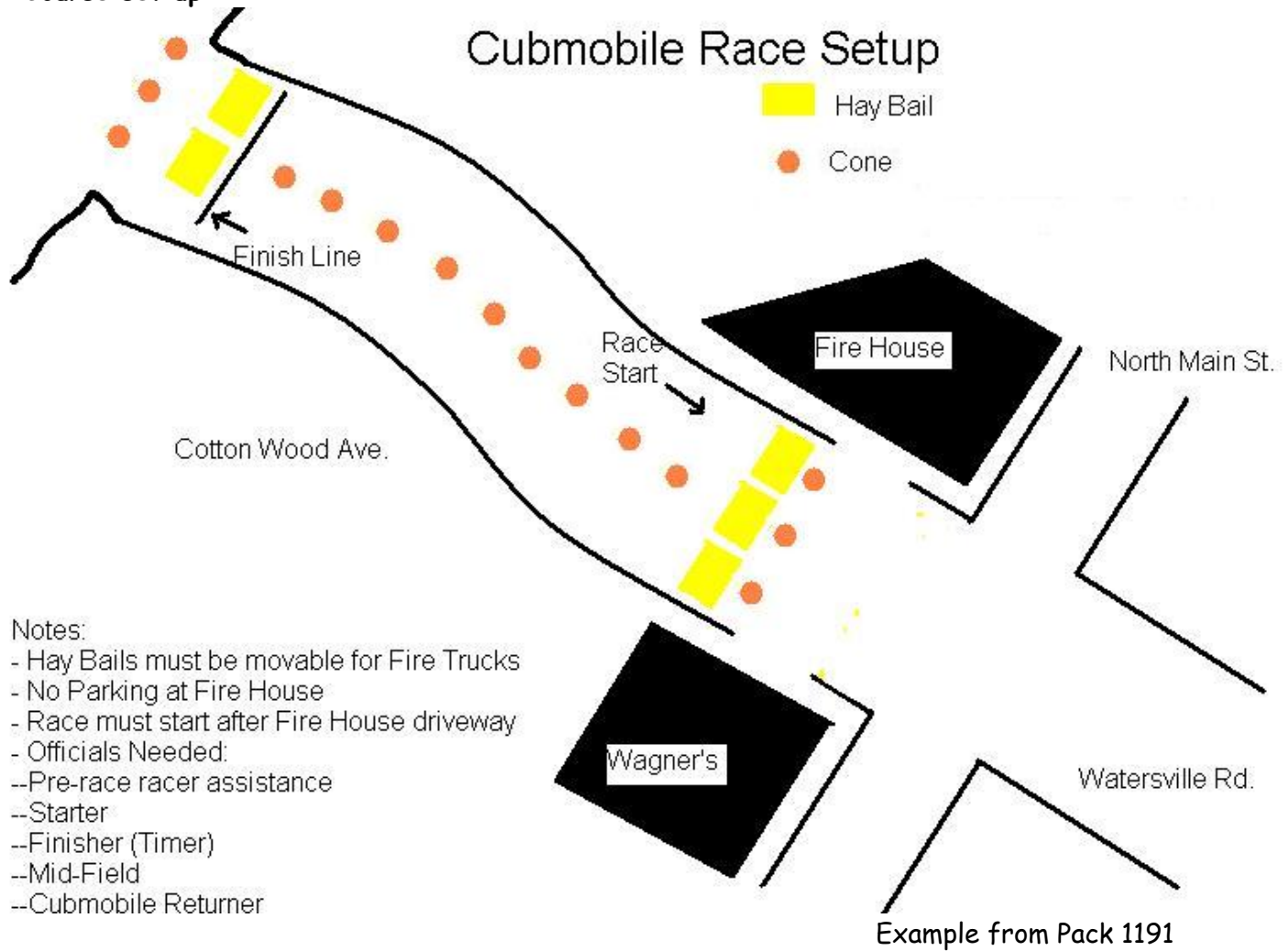
- **You need Cubmobiles** The Bear book has plans in Elective 7, "THINGS THAT GO (Bear Handbook, Page 206)" as well as Cub Scout Leader How-To Book (BSA No. 33832A).
- **Parent permission slip** Make sure the parents understand what the race will entail, how the cubmobiles work etc and make up a written permission slip.
- **Street Closure** Most towns have a form to be filled out for closures that require at least a month advance notice to go before the town council. Some require written permission from the affected citizens (this might affect your choice of tracks!)

GATHERING

- **Pre-race sign-up**
- All boys must sign in and get general safety briefing including how to start and stop cubmobiles. The proper fit of the bicycle helmet will also be checked (All boys are requested to bring their own bicycle helmets but the pack will have some extra.)
- at least 2 parents need to be stationed at the pre-race test area, at least 2 at the starting line, at least 2 along the middle of the track and at least 2 at the end.
- The boys race two at a time. If the course is not wide enough they can race one at a time (against the clock!)
- When the 1st two boys are ready, they are strapped into the cubmobiles. They then:
 - are reacquainted with how the cubmobiles start and stop
 - roll down a 20 - 30 foot "test track" to the actual starting line to make sure they can steer and stop (a parent walks this with them ready to grab them if necessary)
- At the end of the track they boys will need to get the cubmobiles back up to the top of the track. Den Chiefs are GREAT for this...if not them, then you'll need parents.

- We race our cubmobiles two at a time so the boys have a feeling of competition but also time each boy so they have a comparison of how well they did.
