

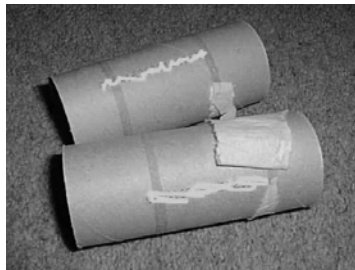

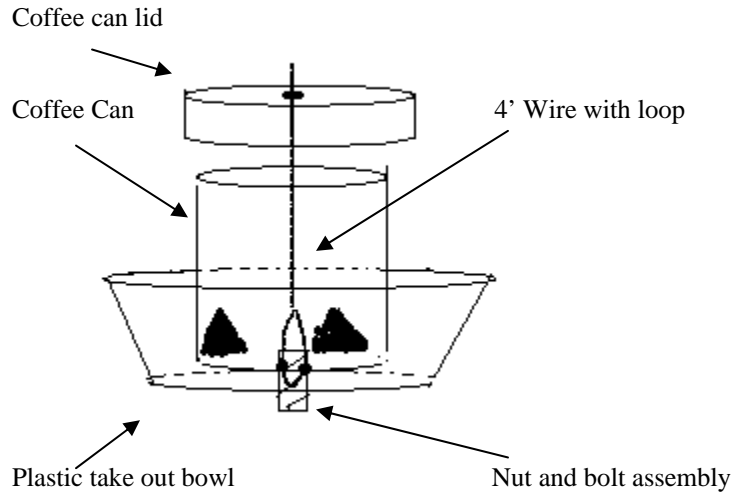
Kids love ripe bananas, they taste so sweet Add their peels to our rotten treat. Pour in a little water, put the bucket outside In about six weeks, look inside!

Coffee Can Bird Feeder



Preparation

1. Punch three holes in the closed side of a coffee can.
2. Punch a hole in the center of the can, for the "nut and bolt assembly.
3. Punch two additional holes in the bottom of the can through which we be looping the wire.
4. Punch holes through the center of the plastic lid of the coffee can lid and the plastic take out bowl.

Assembly

1. Run wire through the lid and loop it through the two holes in the can, and then back through the hole in the lid.
2. Connect the can and the plastic take out bowl using a nut and bolt.
3. Fill the can with appropriate bird feed.
4. Place the lid on can and hang feeder using the wire.
