

RULES FOR THE CAKE DECORATING CONTEST

A highlight of the Blue and Gold banquet is the cake-decorating contest. The creativity and skill of Pack families has been demonstrated over many years of celebrations. We will accept family entries or the traditional father/son cake creations.

These are the rules for the contest:

1. The cake must be made/decorated by the Scout and his immediate family.
2. All entries must be on a disposable plate.
3. All components and decorations must be edible.

An index card must be submitted along with the entry providing (1) the Scout's name, (2) the title of the cake, and (3) a list of all ingredients in and on the cake. If packaged mixes are used, provide the name of the product (i.e. Betty Crocker Devil's Food cake mix) rather than all ingredients in the product.

Cakes will be judged in the following categories:

- Tallest – as determined at the time of entry by tape measure
- The people's choice – as determined by weight of coins in plastic cups
- Best Tiger theme
- Best Scout theme
- Yummiest looking
- Most colorful
- Best "Cubs in the Future" theme

Winning cakes will be auctioned during the banquet; all others will be served as dessert.
